The American Museum of Natural History is located at 79th Street and Central Park West and is easily reached by public transportation. **Program attendees should enter at the Main Entrance on Central Park West at 79th Street.**

Subway: Take the B (weekdays only) or C to 81st Street. Two blocks west of the Museum, the 1 and 9 trains stop at Broadway and West 79th Street.

Bus: The M79 bus travels east/west on W. 79th Street across Central Park, with a stop next to the Museum on W. 81st Street. Other buses also stop at or near the Museum, including the M7, M10, M11, M86 and M104 buses.
